ORDINANCE NO. 16-2488 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”

was introduced at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Tuesday, February 2, 2016, and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the Council Chambers of the Borough Hall located at 198 N. Washington Avenue, Bergenfield, New Jersey on Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 8:00 P.M. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement of this ordinance is to amend Item A under Section 299-10 entitled “Overnight Parking,” to include that no vehicles shall be parked or left standing on certain streets in the Borough between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., as set forth in the ordinance.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD,
ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"**

WHEREAS, Chapter 299 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding Vehicles and Traffic within the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

Section 299-10. Overnight parking.

A.No vehicles shall be parked or left standing on any street in the Borough between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., except as listed below:

Georgian Court	East/West		Excluding any portion of the cul-de-Sac and excluding 50' from the Entrance or exit
Howard Drive	East/West		From Liberty Road running around The bend to Ivy Lane
Ivy Lane	North		From County Bridge west to Liberty Road
Liberty Road	North		From 300 feet east of South Washington Avenue easterly to Ivy Lane
Martin Street	West		Between Hickory Avenue and Johnson Avenue (head-in spaces)
North Railroad Avenue	West	Tues. & Thurs.	From Annex Place to West Church Street
South Railroad Avenue	West	Tues. & Thurs.	From West Clinton Avenue northerly to end of street
Veterans Plaza	West	Mon. & Wed.	From West Church Street southerly 345 feet

The purpose of limiting parking from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. is to ensure that vehicles do not obstruct the collection of refuse by the Department of Public Works.

Severability All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
