ORDINANCE NO. 16-2489 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 215 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED “NOISE”

was introduced at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Tuesday, February 2, 2016, and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the Council Chambers of the Borough Hall located at 198 N. Washington Avenue, Bergenfield, New Jersey on Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 8:00 P.M. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement of this ordinance is to amend Section 215-8 entitled “Specific prohibited acts” to exclude Borough owned and operated vehicles, as set forth in the ordinance.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 215 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD,
ENTITLED "NOISE"**

WHEREAS, Chapter 215 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding Noise within the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

Section 215-8. Specific prohibited acts.

The following acts, among others, excluding Borough owned and operated vehicles, are declared to be loud, disturbing or excessive noise in violation of this chapter, but said enumeration shall not be deemed to be exclusive:

Severability All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
