**TREASURER'S REPORT**

Budget: 88.90

Actual expenditure for Christmas/Holiday party: \$2,191.61 which is an estimate for next year.

To date there is no word from the Borough regarding our 2016 budget. We are awaiting approval from the Borough.

A problem regarding guest attendance at our various venues was discussed. Our seniors have been calling in/signup their reservations too close to the venue date which has become a problem because the venues want a number of reservations at least two weeks before the venue date. Vice President Marge prefers to have sign ups a month before the venue date which will alleviate much of this problem. Therefore, phone call and signup deadlines will be strictly enforced. Also, table seating was discussed – no reserved tables can be allowed. First come, first served.
