**BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD**

**AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "ESTABLISHMENT OF TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD.**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and Council support the establishment of a Traffic Safety Committee in order to study, create, recommend and implement traffic safety plans within the Borough for the purpose of providing safety for all its residents and visitors to the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, establishing a Traffic Safety Committee will raise awareness, provide a more safe environment and respond to the needs of the Borough when it comes to traffic safety at any given time.

Establishment of Traffic Safety Committee.

A. There is hereby created a Traffic Safety Committee consisting of twelve (12) members appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Council from the following sectors:

- i. Mayor
- ii. Council liaison
- iii. Borough Administrator
- iv. Police Department
- v. Department of Public Works
- vi. Board of Education
- vii. Fire Department
- viii. Emergency Management
- ix. Ambulance Corp.
- x. Four (4) Community Representatives

B. Appointments.

The Governing Body shall designate annually one of the members to serve as Chairman and presiding Officer of the Committee.

C. All members shall serve for one (1) year terms commencing on January 1 of each year except for initial appointments made hereunder which shall expire on December 31, 2019. Vacancies shall be filled for unexpired terms only. All members shall serve without compensation.

Powers and Duties.

The Traffic Safety Committee is hereby granted and shall have and exercise in addition to the other powers herein granted, all the powers necessary and appropriate to carry out and execute the purposes of this section, including but not limited to the following:

(a) to study, create, and recommend traffic safety plans within the Borough.

Severability All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
